- 2) We have managed to arrange cheap accommodation in “Tent City” – especially for young people:

TENT CITY - Registration online @ www.anglicansablaze.org

We have arranged the use of the Boy Scout Camp at Delta Park in Randburg. This site is only 14km from the venue and can accommodate up to 700 people.

There are 3 camping options:

1. Bring your own tent and sleeping bag.
2. Use the communal tents provided, bring your own sleeping bag.
3. Use your own caravan, note there is no electricity available & the sand is soft.

The cost to use the campsite is R195 for the 4 days (3 nights), and this includes a basic breakfast.

Optional Extras:

Transportation | R180: To and from O.R. Tambo Airport or Park Station bus terminal, the camp site and the venue.

Supper | R120: 3 X hot meals with drink.
