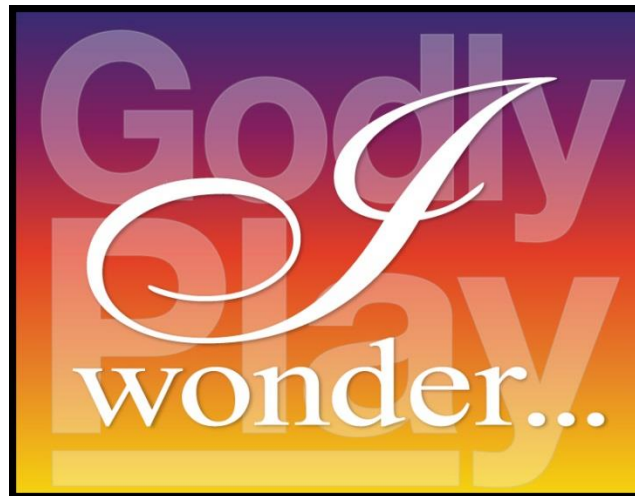


? Godly Play ?



There are lots of things you can learn from books or a lecture, but Godly Play needs to be experienced with heart and mind.

A practical demonstration of Godly Play can be presented as either:

- 1. A short orientation to Godly Play lasting between 1 ½ to 3 hours**
- 2. A full Godly Play Introductory Workshop lasting between 6 and 8 hours**

This Montessori-based story-telling approach is quite different from the traditional model in which the teacher tells the children what they need to know. Godly Play is *not* just about learning lessons or keeping children entertained. Godly Play respects the innate spirituality of children and encourages curiosity and imagination in experiencing the mystery and joy of God. Godly Play teaches children the art of using Christian language - parable, sacred story, silence and liturgical action - helping them become more fully aware of the mystery of God's presence in their lives.

The goal of Godly Play is to show how to be open to the Holy Spirit, The Creator, and the Redeemer all at once and all the time in every place.
