

MANAGING LOSS, GRIEF AND CONTINUOUS TRAUMA

- *Are there people in your community who experience loss, grief and trauma?*

The Warehouse has developed and tested a programme that reduces the effects of loss, grief and trauma in communities where professional help is limited. The programme improves overall health and self-esteem, and deepens faith in a context of despair. The course on offer will equip mental health professionals working in resource-deprived settings to use the programme to help people process their loss, grief and trauma and find hope.
